P(UK)

This show is a qualifier for the P(UK) Summer National Championships to be held at Newark & Notts Showground, NG24 2NY. 8th – 11th August 2012.

1st, 2nd and 3rd placed ponies/cobs in **each** Ponies Association (UK) Summer National Championships Qualifying classes will qualify. Qualification will pass **no lower than 3rd place**.

Qualification is open to **Members & Non-Members** of Ponies Association (UK).

Once qualified if the owner is not a current “A” member, the rider/handler is not a current “A” or Junior/Senior riders club member and/or the pony/cob is not currently registered with Ponies Association (UK), then they have **14 days** to submit their memberships/registrations in order for the qualification to remain valid.

Qualifications will be verified by the show secretary when the results are sent into the Ponies Association (UK) office. Lee Smith Members receive a summer competition card for each eligible currently registered Home Produced pony, which must be signed by a judge or steward in the ring; this applies to the highest placed Lee Smith Member.

Once owner, rider/handler, pony/cob are registered **entries must be made** on the official Ponies Association (UK) Summer National Championship Entry Form. Once published these can be obtained from the Ponies Association (UK) website or by sending an A5 SAE with large letter stamp to the Ponies Association (UK) office. **All entries must be sent into the Ponies Association (UK) office before the closing date for entries.**

Equifest

This show is affiliated to Equifest, taking place at the East of England Showground, on 16th – 19th August 2012. The champion and reserve in the Sec A, Sec B, Sec C and Sec D championships will qualify and the two highest exhibits not already qualified in each affiliated ridden class will qualify. It is the exhibitor’s responsibility to have a qualifying card in their possession for signature in the ring.

Note: Classes 1, 2, 3, 4, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 22 & 23 are P(UK) Qualifiers and in classes 26-29, 31-36, 38-43, 45-50 and 52-53 inclusive, 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize winners qualify for the P(UK) Glyn Greenwood Championship.

Classes 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20 & 21 are Equifest Qualifiers

TROPHIES

Please note only fully paid up members of EWPCA will be allowed to take trophies. The Association will be prepared to have trophies engraved for non-members upon payment of £15.00.

This ruling has been introduced to prevent the disappearance or late return of trophies.

RULES FOR RIDDEN CLASSES

1. All ridden ponies must be 4 years old or over and registered in the Pure Bred section of their Mountain and Moorland Breed Society's Stud Book or in the Part-Bred section of their Breed Society.
2. The Judge's decision is final.
3. Manes and tails to be left unplaited **including part-breds**.
4. EWP&CA reserve the right to alter classes or judges without notice.
5. EWP&CA accept no responsibility for any loss or damage.
6. Juniors who have not attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year may not ride small breed stallions.
7. Juniors who have not attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year may not ride large breed stallions.
8. Hard hats, to approved current BSI Standard, to be worn and correctly secured at all times when mounted. Spurs/dress spurs not to be worn.
9. Show canes/whips not to exceed 30" / 75 cms. In Lead Rein classes plain or leather covered canes **ONLY** may be used.
10. In First Ridden classes ponies must not be cantered except in their individual show.
11. Anyone causing a disturbance, of any kind, will be asked to leave the show-ground, forfeiting all entry fees.
12. Objections must be made in writing within 15 minutes of the finish of the class accompanied by a deposit of £15.00.

A special rosette will be presented to the highest placed Welsh Section A, B, C or D pony/cob in all ridden classes and that pony/cob will qualify for the WELSH Ridden Championship.

Lead rein to be attached to the noseband only. Rider not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1 January in the current year.
- 2. P(UK) BRINETON CONFINED NOVICE M&M FIRST RIDDEN** – Confined Novice mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128 cms. Registered in their approved Pure Breed Society Stud Books of Shetland, Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest and Welsh Section A or B. Not to have won a first prize of £10 or more in any open M&M First Ridden class. To be shown in any suitable bridle. Rider not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1 January in the current year.
- 3. P(UK) LOBSTER POT M&M LEAD REIN** – Open M&M Lead Rein, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122 cms. Registered in their approved Pure Breed Society Stud Books of Shetland, Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest and Welsh Section A or B. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle. Lead rein to be attached to the noseband only. Rider not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1 January in the current year.
- 4. P(UK) BRINETON M&M FIRST RIDDEN** – Open M&M, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128 cms. Registered in their approved Pure Breed Society Stud Books of Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Shetland and Welsh Section A or B. To be shown in any suitable bridle. Rider not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year.
- 5. FIRST SEASON – FIRST RIDDEN** – mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128 cms. Open to Shetland, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Welsh A or B and small part-bred ponies registered in their approved Pure Breed Society Stud Books or in the Part-Bred Section of their Breed Society. Ridden by a child **in first season off the lead rein** not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1 January in the current year.

NOTE: THIS CLASS HAS BEEN PUT ON TO GIVE SMALL CHILDREN A CHANCE TO COMPETE OFF THE LEAD REIN BEFORE JOINING THE MORE EXPERIENCED CHILDREN. PLEASE ONLY ENTER IF YOUR CHILD **HAS NOT COMPETED** OFF THE LEAD REIN PRIOR TO THIS SEASON.

7. **PONY IN ITS FIRST SEASON RIDDEN – Large Breeds** - stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Registered in their respective Pure Breed Society Stud Books of Connemara, Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Welsh C or D or in the Part-Bred Section of their Breed Society. Rider any age. (See Rule 7).
8. **P(UK) KINGSFORD CONFINED NOVICE RIDDEN M&M PONY - Small Breeds** – confined novice M&M stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Registered in their approved Pure Breed Society Stud Books of Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh Section A or B. Not to have won a first prize of £10.00 or more in any open ridden M&M class at any show before 1 January in the current year. Rider any age (See Rule 6).
9. **P(UK) KINGSFORD CONFINED NOVICE RIDDEN M&M PONY - Large Breeds** – confined novice M&M stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Registered in their approved Pure Breed Society Stud Books of Connemara, Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Welsh Section C or D. Not to have won a first prize of £10.00 or more in any open ridden M&M class at any show before 1 January in the current year. Rider any age (See Rule 7).

Topthorn Equestrian Centre Grove Farm, Stonham Aspal, Stowmarket, Suffolk, IP14 6BX

From A14 travel to the A140 junction and then travel northwards on the A140 until the A1120 junction; then follow the directions below.

From A140 take A1120 signposted Stonham Aspal, past 30 mph signs, turn left towards Millgreen/Mickfield. After 1.2 miles keep right towards Debenham. Topthorn is 1 mile on your left hand side.

From Debenham take Gracechurch street out of the village, past High School and Community Centre, follow road for 2 miles, ignoring turning to Mickfield. Topthorn is 1 mile at top of hill on your right hand side.
